# Scope and Sequence of Skills

# **Prepare**

Throughout Musicplay new concepts are prepared by singing, playing and listening. Learning music is like learning a language. Children need to experience music before labeling it.

# **Present**

When children have experienced a new concept (ie. beat) they are ready to label it. When the teacher labels a new concept in this method, it is called "present" - a new concept is made conscious or presented to the students.

# **Practice**

After a new concept is presented, the children need reinforcement, or practice. New musical terms or concepts are reviewed throughout Musicplay.

## **BEAT AND RHYTHM**

# **INSTRUMENTAL TECHNIQUE**

- identify and play unpitched and barred instruments
- simple bordun on barred instruments, both hands at the same time

#### **CREATING**

- create "effects" wind, rain, animal
- make up answers to musical questions
- create rhythm patterns
- create movements appropriate for the music
- invent melodies for chants, nursery rhymes

#### **FORM**

- music is organized into phrases
- phrases can be the same or different (ab)
- use repeat sign
- AB, ABA sectional form

#### **EXPRESSION**

- the beat can be fast or slow (tempo)
- music may be soft or loud (dynamics)
- can tell how music makes us feel
- articulation show detached (separated) and connected (smooth) notes

#### **CULTURAL/HISTORICAL CONTEXT**

- identify songs that help us celebrate holidays, seasons
- perform songs from a variety of cultural heritages

# **LISTENING**

- distinguish different voices (timbre)
- identify classroom instruments (timbre)
- identify environmental sounds
- follow song stories ie. Mortimer
- listen and respond to short orchestral excerpts

## INTEGRATED CURRICULUM



accent - means to emphasize the note

adagio - slow

**Bach, Johann Sebastian (1685-1750)** - one of the greatest composers of the Baroque age

bar - the distance between two bar lines

bar line - a line that divides music into bars or measures

**beat** - most music has a steady beat or pulse that you can feel, step, clap or dance to

**bow** - a wooden stick with horsehair stretched from end to end used to play string instruments

**brass family** - includes the trumpet, cornet, French horn, trombone, and tuba

**double reed** - two pieces of cane, tied together used to make sound in the oboe and bassoon

**dynamics** - dynamics tell us how loud or soft the music should be played or sung

form - how you organize music

forte - loud

**legato** - means to smoothly connect the notes. Legato is shown by placing a curved line over a group of notes.

measure - the distance between two bar lines

moderato - medium speed

**Mozart, Wolfgang Amadeus (1756-1791)** - one of the most brilliant composers ever known

**percussion family** - a group of instruments that are hit or shaken to make sound. This family includes snare drum, bass drum, timpani, and many small rhythm instruments.

piano - soft

pitch - pitch tells us how high or low the note is

presto - very quickly

prestissimo - as fast as you can go

**reed** - small piece of cane, that is attached to the mouthpiece of a woodwind instrument. When the reed vibrates, it makes the sound.

rondo - form A B A C A etc

**rhythm** - rhythm in music is "the way the words go"

solfa - a way of naming notes that singers use

staff - five lines upon which music is written

staccato - means to play the note in a detached style. It

is shown by placing a dot over or under the note.

**string family** - includes the violin, viola, cello and double bass

**tempo** - tempo tells us how fast or slow the music should be played

**tie** - joins two notes together. Hold for the value of both the notes

timbre - the sound of a voice or instrument

**treble clef** - circles the note G, and is used for treble, or higher notes

woodwind family - includes the flute, oboe, English horn, bassoon, clarinet and saxophone. Except for the saxophone, all these instruments were once made of wood. They were all played by blowing with air or wind, so they were called "woodwind".
